Show starts at 9:00 am SHARP. Show will be held in Indoor arena.

Trail will be held starting at 11:00 am until 4:00 pm outside on the small dirt warmup ring. The Western classes are spread out to give each age division plenty of time to go and do trail.

ENTRY FEES - \$7. / class. \$20. / stake class ENTRIES CLOSE Aug. 13

POST ENTRIES – Double entry Fees after closing date. With no Exceptions

Money Payout will be 1st - \$20. 2nd - \$15. 3rd - \$10.

4 placings in Stakes classes – 40% - 30% - 20% - 10% \$100 added to each stake class

Rules & Regulations

1. The Show Committee reserves the right to combine or split any class they see fit, depending on the amount of entries.
2. Anyone harassing or interfering with the Judge or any Official at the Horse Show will be asked to leave and entry fee will be forfeited.
3. Entries must be on the official entry form and signed by the exhibitor and/or Parent/Guardian.
4. Each exhibitor when signing the entry form, agrees that the Rimbey Show and workers will not be held responsible for any injuries or damage to animals or property while attending this show.
5. Each exhibitor is responsible for his/her animals & his/her entry form.
6. A horse can not be cross-entered within a class. Up to 3 horses can be ridden in non-rail class.
7. Cruelty to or abuse of a horse by any person at the Show is forbidden. The Judge or Show Committee has the authority to dismiss from a class, or the Show, any exhibitor for cruelty to, or the abuse of a horse and entry fee will be forfeited.
8. The Judge has the authority to dismiss any entry from the arena if the entry does not have the proper tack or is lame. The entry fee will be forfeited.
9. Use of whips or bats of any type is prohibited in any Classes.
10. No Junior Exhibitors are permitted to show stallions.
11. Any exhibitor lodging a protest must make it in writing within 24hrs after the close of the show and it shall be accompanied by a deposit of \$50.00 which will be forfeited to the Society if the protest is not upheld.
12. Gate will be kept open for minimum of time to allow for fast changes in attire and tack. Please inform the gate person.
13. Entry fees will only be refunded on a receipt of a vet certificate for horse or Doctors certificate for rider.
14. Western Division – all entrants must wear long sleeved shirts, western hat and boots and western tack. No tie downs or martingales. All shank bits must have chin straps.
15. No horse boots except in Reining.
16. English Division – English attire, hard hats. A harness on Hard Hats must be worn for Riders under 18yrs. English tack. No tie downs, martingales or figure 8 or drop nose bands.
17. Jr. Horse is a horse must be 5 years or younger. Can be shown in a shank bit. No cross entry with other age divisions.
18. A red ribbon should be worn in the tail of a horse that kicks.
19. Class announcements and hitching post reminders are a courtesy. It is up to the individual rider to be ready at time of class entry.
20. WALK/TROT – a competitor can enter in walk/trot classes either as a novice rider or on a novice horse however either horse or rider are not eligible to enter any of the other loping classes except that they may enter Halter & Showmanship.
21. The presentation and signing of your entry form shall be deemed acceptance of these rules and absolves the committee of any responsibility and liability.

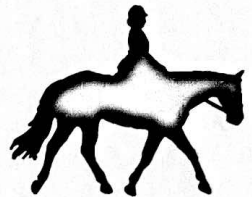
